GOOD NEWS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

Stage 3 of the Amy Gillett Bikeway between Charleston and Mount Torrens

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure have over the last few weeks, met most property owners adjacent to the corridor to discuss this project and hear their issues and concerns. DPTI are currently finalising the detailed drawings which are expected to be available for public display in the New Year.

Construction will be undertaken in two stages with the first stage being Charleston to Hartmann Road and Lenger Road to Oval Road, Mount Torrens, to be completed in the first half of 2013, and the section between Hartmann Road and Lenger Road to be completed in the second half of the year.
